Pre Match Meeting	Did you have a pre match meeting with both coaches before the game?			
Kick Off	Was a Punt Kick used to start the game and again at the start of the second half?			
Restart After a Try or Penalty kick	Was the ball on the ground for the Tap Kick and did it go a visible distance? <i>(The Player tapping the ball is allowed to run.)</i>			
Walla Tag:	Were all Walla Tags with open palms of <b>both hands (simultaneously) below the waist</b> and above the knee?			
Referee's Call once Tagged	Is this the call you made? <b>"TAG--PASS--PASS--PASS"</b> (This is the exact call, no other and not shortened.)			
Referee's Call once Tagged & player has run on further	Did you make this call if the player over ran the mark? TAG-- <b>BACK UP--BACKUP</b> --PASS--PASS--PASS			
Attempted Walla Tag:	If any defender tagged the ball carrier above the waist, did Referee call : <b>"Play on--Too High"</b>			
Attempted Walla Tag:	If any defender tagged the ball carrier with only one hand, did Referee call : <b>"Play on--Only One hand"</b>			
Attempted Walla Tag:	If any defending players were Holding, Grabbing, Pulling, Pushing etc penalised immediately? <i>(This constitutes undue rough play).</i>			
Offside at Ball Take	Did you as Referee insist on the Offside Lines set <b>5 metres</b> from <b>last Defender's Feet</b> ? <i>(Not where the ball carrier and support player are standing).</i>			
Ball Take: Ref's call.	Did you as referee call <b>"release"</b> when you were happy that the all players were in position? <i>This signals to the support player (who cannot run) to pass the ball. Remember that where the team has set up the Ball Take in general play the support player may pass at any time.</i>			
Offside in General Play	As Referee, do you know that a Walla Tag does not set an Offside Line? <b>It is not until you call "Ball-Take" that the offside line is set.</b> ( See Competition Registrar email text on General Play and Offside below or refer to Law Book and Walla Rugby CD. See www.bjru.com.au under "Education and Development" Walla Tag Clarified".)			
Forward Pass/Throw Forward	Did you allow the game to continue and say to the player in the run. "Pass it backwards next time". <i>Have the player's coach re enforce your call.</i>			
Knock On	Did you let it go? ( In under 6, always let it go to allow a free flowing game.)			
Player running out of Touch	If Touches judges pushed them it, and play continued it fine. If a stoppage did occur, did you bring it back in 5 metres and start with a ball take to the attacking team?			
Fending	If any Player attempted to "Fend", was the player warned and penalised?			
Scoring a Try:	If any player was Tagged over the Line, was the try awarded? <i>A legal tag over the line does not count. A legal tag before the line does count.</i>			
Walla Tag just before crossing the Try Line:	Did you as referee reward the defender for a successful Walla Tag just before the try line? <i>Even if it is 1cm the defender is to be rewarded and the tagged player is to pass the ball or a ball take is to be formed 5 metres out from the goal line.</i>			
Diving to Score a Try:	If any player dived to score a try, was it disallowed and bought back 5 metres for a Ball take? <b><u>Diving to score a try is not permitted.</u></b> <i>Attacking Team retains the ball. Players must be on their feet when scoring a Try.</i>			
BJRU Directive	As Referee did you follow the BJRU Directive for your age group?			

**Congratulations if you have answered "YES" to all of the above. If you answered No, please refer to the Walla Laws / BJRU Directive and rectify your game.**

<b>Under 6</b>	There will be no Scrum or Lineout. These will be replaced by the Static Ball Take: For a scrum – where the scrum would have been set; and For a lineout - 5 metres in from where the Lineout would have been set. The Moving Ball Take is not permitted at this age.
<b>Offside in General Play. A Walla Tag is "General Play"</b>	"...they are not offside at the tag unless they were already offside due to set play. That means if a team has gone forward from set play (Ball Take, Scrum, Lineout, Penalty etc) running & passing the ball, then defenders cannot be offside.
